AB 1234 ETHICS TRAINING

BACKGROUND:

State law (AB 1234) requires that all legislative bodies, including not only the governing body of a local agency, but also a commission, committee, board or other body that receive compensation, salary, stipends, or expense reimbursements must receive training in public service ethics laws and principles every two years.
