  - Manager, Program Support Services Report Ms. Brenda Campos-Peck Ms. Dermott reported for Ms. Campos-Peck on Immunization Reporting, enrollment process for children with preexisting health conditions, the next Child Safety

Committee meeting (Friday, October 17<sup>th</sup>, 9:00 a.m.), availability of physical and dental forms and TB Policy at SETA Head Start's website (www.headstart.seta. net), and the elimination of pork being served at Head Start centers effective December 1, 2008 (report distributed).

➤ Manager, Parent/Family Support Report – Ms. Lisa Carr – Ms. Dermott reported for Ms. Carr on the Legal Clinic (October 29<sup>th</sup>, Hometown Buffett, 9:00 a.m.), the Parent/Staff Safety Committee, and the cancellation of the Men's Health Fair due to lack of participation (only two signed up). Ms. Dermott shared that (centers) are not fully enrolled. Staff is working on strategies for full enrollment. Under the new Reauthorization there is a requirement nationwide that Head Starts have full enrollment at all times (report distributed).

Ms. Jeanine Vandermolen asked if the Men's Health Fair would be rescheduled. Ms. Dermott asked Ms. Desha to inquire and report back. Ms. Vandermolen asked if SETA was aware that the Men's Health Fair was the same date as the First 5's celebration day. Ms. Dermott shared that SETA participated in the celebration. Ms. Vandermolen believes more parents would have participated had they known it was a joint venture between SETA and First 5. Ms. Salina Davey clarified that SETA wasn't involved with First 5 at William Land Park, First 5 was scheduled to make a presentation at Hiram Johnson. - ➤ Head Start Deputy Director's Report Ms. Maureen Dermott
  - Ms. Dermott reported on the attached SETA Head Start/Early Head Start End of the Month Enrollment Report. Enrollments are down for SOP. Ending August, '08, SETA's total enrollment was 2,698, and 2,606 for September '08. SETA's funding is for 2,778. The Delegates are doing well. Recruitment efforts have only yielded one child enrolled, out of ten possible enrollees. Enrollment/recruitment efforts are continual at all levels.
  - SETA was contacted to host a press conference Friday, October 10<sup>th</sup>, at the Sharon Neese Early Learning Center, regarding the two bills that passed, AB2759 (Assemblyman Jones), which closes the achievement gap and implements Superintendent O'Connell's P-16 recommendation; and Senate Bill 1629 (Senator Steinburg), designed to establish a council for developing a preschool quality improvement system. Visitors were State Superintendent of Public Instruction, Jack O'Connell; Senator Darrell Steinburg; Assembly Member Dave Jones: President of Preschool California, Catherine Atkins: Child Now President, Ted Manford; California Child Development Administrators Association Executive Director; and the Sacramento Police Chief. SETA Head Start had an All Staff Meeting of 451 employees Monday (October 13, 2008). The meeting called "It's A New Day" was held to assure all staff understood the implications of reauthorization, and how Community Care Licensing is tightening up. Some of the issues discussed were full enrollment, lost children, children's personal rights - issues which can cost an agency their grant. If PAC would like to know what staff were informed, Ms. Dermott will be happy to provide a presentation.

Ms. Itzel Oregon, Countrywood Head Start, shared that it's been a challenging beginning of the year due to the change of the FSW. There are two new FSW's. They are getting familiar with the children, and working very hard. Parents are new and they're trying to
