At a Special Meeting on Thursday, April 27 2017, the Governing Board of the Sacramento Employment and Training Agency (SETA), a Joint Powers Agency of the City and County of Sacramento, approved the release of a Request for Proposals (RFP) for refugee program services funded under the Refugee Social Services (RSS), Targeted Assistance (TA), and RSS Set-aside grants.
