Re: Letter of Understanding on Amendment to the Release of Driver License Information for Employees Driving as Part of the Job

Dear Jeremiah:

This is to confirm the agreement of the Sacramento Employment and Training Agency (SETA) and the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees District Council 57, Local 146, AFL-CIO (AFSCME) to amend the DMV records review process by releasing the employee record to the Agency insurance broker automatically in response to a driving incident so long as driving is an essential function of the job.

Specifically, it is agreed, as follows:

- Currently the Agency insurance broker, Arthur J. Gallagher & Company, receives information annually on all employees whose job includes driving as an essential element.
- Going forward the insurance broker will receive information on these individual employee records in response to a driving incident that affects the employee's Department of Motor Vehicle driving record.
