Mr. Walker advised that Blue Diamonds Almonds Company is relocating from the Sacramento area and laying off its employees in phases. Their headquarters will remain in the area.

Ms. Mechals informed the Committee that the Youth Committee will hold its next meeting on July 16, 2025, at 2:00 p.m. at Goodwill Industries' location.

Mr. Kim introduced Ms. May-Va Vang, the newest member of the Sacramento Works, Inc. Board.

He also shared that SETA is actively monitoring developments regarding the federal budget. Mr. Kim emphasized that funding allocations for the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) have been received and show significant increases: Adult and Youth funding is up by 16%, while funding for Dislocated Workers has increased by 30%. All the Youth providers and job centers' funding was extended.

The Community Services Block Grant (CSBG) and Refugee Social Services programs, which SETA administers, continued to be proposed for elimination.

Mr. Kim noted that any proposed reductions will not have an immediate impact on the Agency.

Additionally, Mr. Kim advised that SETA signed a contract for a James Irvine Foundation grant that was recently awarded and is in the process of accessing the funds. He encouraged members to apply to become a member of the Cross-Advisory Board, one of the grant proposal initiatives, when recruitment begins.
